

OhioMATYC Student Scholarships

Purpose of the Awards

The purpose of the OhioMATYC Student Scholarships is to encourage the study of mathematics by students enrolled in institutions of higher education.

Criteria

1. Each qualifying **institution** may submit **one** nomination. Institutions with at least 8 active OhioMATYC members may nominate one additional student for a total of **two** students. To be a qualifying institution, the institution must employ at least one member in good standing of OhioMATYC.
2. The student(s) must be nominated by a current OhioMATYC member who is a current employee of the qualifying institutions.
3. The nominated student must have taken a minimum of 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours of college credit courses, and a minimum of 30 quarter hours or 20 semester hours must have been taken at the nominating institution.
4. The nominated student must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0 in the college credit courses, and a minimum GPA of 3.5 in their mathematics courses.
5. The nominated student must have either:
 - a) taken a minimum of 9 quarter-hours or 6 semester-hours of college mathematics, including one calculus, business calculus, or technical calculus course at the nominating institution.**OR**
 - b) taken a minimum of 15 quarter-hours or 10 semester-hours of college mathematics at the nominating institution.
6. The nominated student must be enrolled at the nominating institution at the time of nomination or have completed at least one mathematics course at the institution during the **calendar** year.

Method of Selection

1. The faculty at each institution should announce to all students in college level courses that the scholarship exists. Students who meet the criteria should be invited to submit an application to the Mathematics Department, who will determine the nominee(s).
2. Each institution should then select the one (or two) student(s) it wishes to nominate (from their applicant pool) and then send the one (or two) student's nomination form(s) **and** official transcript(s) back to the Awards Coordinator of OhioMATYC. If submitting two nominees, please note the 1st and 2nd choices. The nomination form with official transcript must be received by **the scheduled deadline**.
3. Scholarship recipients will be determined by a random draw once the nominees have been carefully screened to make sure that they fulfill the above criteria. The drawing will take place at the Spring Executive Committee meeting or be conducted electronically among the Executive Committee.
4. The scholarship money (\$300 each) will be sent to the recipients (via the nominators) after the winners are determined.

AMATYC Presidential Student Scholarship

OhioMATYC will submit a nomination for one student from qualified applicants (selected by random draw) for the AMATYC Presidential Student Scholarship. To qualify, in addition to meeting the OhioMATYC Scholarship requirements, students must also be majoring in mathematics, enrolled fulltime during the spring semester, and nominated by an AMATYC member.
